THE CAPTAIN TODD CHRISTMAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Texas Cauble Family Association is offering scholarship assistance to a graduating high school senior, other Texas college students or Vocational school registrants who are descendants of the Cauble family line beginning or pursuing a degree from a Texas institution of higher learning. The scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 per academic year is based on need and merit. With proof of passing grades applicant may apply for a second year.

An application will be sent upon request and is due by May 1st to the Scholarship Committee for their recommendation to the Board of Directors of Texas Cauble Family Association.

The scholarship is to be awarded in the summer at the Texas Cauble Family Association meeting.

Requirements are:

1. Descendant of Peter Cauble and Mary Ann Rotan.
Family membership in the TCFA.
2. Graduate from high school by spring in the top 25% of class.
3. Intent to attend a Texas institution of higher learning. Waiver of Texas requirement may be granted by Board of Directors.

Materials requested:

1. Complete and submit the attached application form by May 1st to the Scholarship Committee Chairman. (Jane Levý, 12406 Burlywood Trail, Austin TX 78750. Telephone 512.258.2668.)
2. Essay: Describe on one page your educational objectives and future goals. Essay must be typed and attached to the Application. Indicate why you have a need and include the following information: *list of extracurricular activities, clubs and organizations, awards, community service participation, special skills and talents, any employment you have held while in high school and any other information you feel is pertinent to your application.*
